I am sure you were all very excited to hear that Auckland moved to Alert-Level 1 at midday today. We are welcoming the opportunity to follow Alert-Level 1 procedures from Monday. Some may wonder why we followed Alert-Level 2 procedures at the end of the day today. Children do better when routines are consistent and to change procedures in the middle of the day can be confusing for some children, so we maintained our procedures for the full day.

Thank you for your support over the last two weeks. I remind everyone that Alert-Level 1 is not Alert-Level 0 and we must still follow good health and safety procedures at school. We still have increased hand washing and cleaning procedures and we still require families to sign in using the COVID app when you enter the school grounds. As we have mentioned previously, consider continuing a little of the independence your children have had this week, by dropping at the gate in the morning and picking up at the classroom in the afternoon.

It has been a fantastic week at Rutherford Primary. Earlier this week room 16 did some great learning about seeds.
